Creative ways to keep your members and peers engaged

- Start a book club or movie night

- Organize a Korean food potluck
 - Everyone loves free food! Have students make their favorite Korean dish or order from a local Korean restaurant
- Gather students together for the annual Korea Peace advocacy week.
